There's a new scam in town! The Hardin County Sheriff called to let us know that a new scam has been circulating and unfortunately, a few folks have fallen victim. We know how hard our customers work toward their retirement and are so sad to hear

about these scams that target our retired population. The new scam is very similar to the grandparent scam but has a new twist. A caller identifies themselves as an attorney representing their grandchild. They tell the victim their grandchild has had a gag order placed on them and can't communicate with family. The "attorney" then tells them that law enforcement has instructed them to get cash for bail money and tell the bank they are doing a home improvement project. Once they get the cash, a courier is sent to their house to pick up the money. Of course, the courier is not legitimate and is part of the scam. **Anytime you receive a phone call with urgency to act and get cash for any purpose, you can safely assume it is a scam.** Talk to a family member or a trusted friend and tell them about the call. They can help you determine the legitimacy and help you protect your hard earned money.
